**Mark Cosgrove's** distinctive, creative flatpicking guitar sound is known and respected on both sides of the Atlantic, through both his own recordings and as a sideman and session player for **Jerry Douglas** and others.

Mark Cosgrove has won the U.S. **National Flatpicking Guitar Championship** in Winfield, Kansas and also the **Doc Watson Guitar Championship** in Wilkesboro, North Carolina. His flatpick guitar work is notable not only for power, precision, and tone, but for his fluid high speed improvisation. Mark is equally proficient in any number of musical styles and as an accompanist, can back a singer or soloist with taste and sensitivity.





The Acoustic Guitar Workshop is an intensive musical study program where participants come from all over the world to create an **international community** of musicians, all living together and sharing the learning experience.

The **non-competitive atmosphere** and well-balanced program provide students with the perfect setting for learning **flatpicking** style, taking chances, and **interacting** with other musicians.

Whether you just started playing acoustic guitar this year and want to get going in the **right direction**, or you've been playing for many years and want to further **develop your craft**, you will find what you're looking for at Acoustic Guitar Workshop.

**Number of participants:**

In order to teach each student better, there are only **18 available slots**.

**Schedule:**

There will be guitar classes in the morning and in the afternoon.  
Participants will be divided into two groups according to their level. All participants will have classes with both instructors.  
Each night will be a different experience!  
There are no scheduled instructional classes on Wednesday morning and on Sunday afternoon.  
All the exercises and pieces are supported by a **book** printed in both standard and tablature notation and by a **CD**.  
The remaining time may be spent as desired: to practice, jam sessions, trips, relaxing, eating and so on.

**Albergo Recoaro 1000:**

There are lots of hiking trails, you can choose from a few-hours strolls to full day's hikes with great scenery to the picks of Piccole Dolomiti mountains.

Albergo Recoaro 1000 (Tel. +39 0445 77115): Via Cima Tunche 23, Loc. Recoaro Mille, 36076 Recoaro Terme. The resort is located 37 Km north of Highway A4 Exit.  
On Highway A4 take exit **Alte di Montecchio** and follow road signs to Valdagno/Recoaro.  
In Valdagno follow road signs to Recoaro Terme, after about 3 Km turn left towards Fongara/strada Recoaro Mille. Drive the steep road for 8,9 Km and take a left onto Via Tunche.

## What to Bring to the Acoustic Guitar Workshop 2010

- Guitars, picks, capo, strings, tuner, music stand, etc.
- Other acoustic instruments are welcome ... jam sessions will be better!
- Clothing: June temperature is generally between 22-25 Celsius during the day and 15-18 in the evening/night. Bring appropriate clothing.
- A mp3 recorder or minidisk recorder: be sure to bring a recorder device to better preserve your workshop experience.
- A flashlight: for getting around to those late night jams!
- A watch/ alarm clock: optional but advisable, you won't get much sleep.
- Cellular phone: optional but inadvisable if you want to immerse yourself in the workshop spirit.
- Money (and lots of it!): the instructors will bring CDs, instructional books, T-shirts, strings, picks, etc. for sale.
